Bids shall be made on the bid form provided and, in the manner, prescribed. They shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes bearing the legend, **Providing Preventative Maintenance and Repair Services for the Security Door Systems at the Cumberland County Jail, Bid # 22-03** on the outside. The bids shall be returned to the Office of the Director of Purchasing, Cumberland County Administration Building, 164 West Broad Street, Bridgeton, New Jersey, 08302, by Friday January 28, 2022, 2:30 PM prevailing time, when they will be opened and read in public. Late bids will not be considered.

Due to the Public Health Emergency caused by the novel coronavirus widely known as “COVID-19”, the County must adhere to the regulations within N.J.A.C. 5:34-8.5. Pursuant to these regulations, the County is unable to accommodate in-person attendance at the Request for Bid opening for public health reasons and shall broadcast the opening live from the opening location.
