- Family hardship or emergency (Covid-19, natural disaster, family illness, divorce, domestic violence, job loss, etc.)
- Car broke down and unable to repair
- This is a short term solution to transportation barriers

Transportation Assistance Program





Many areas of Cumberland County do not have access to grocery stores, pharmacies, health care facilities and employment - our program strives to overcome some of those barriers. Through funding provided by Cumberland County Human Services and the Human Services Advisory Council, our Direct Transportation Assistance Program aims to promote the well-being of children and families in Cumberland County by reducing and/or eliminating transportation barriers.

We are currently taking referrals from agencies who are working with families in need of transportation assistance in the form of an Uber gift card or Riggins gas gift certificate's.

For Uber gift cards the Uber App must be downloaded on a cellular phone and the customer must input a credit card or debit card number in to their Uber account in order to add the gift card. Recipients must be at least 18 years old to use Uber without an adult.
