OVERVIEW OF THE CATS SERVICE:

- Demand Response
- Operates from 8 am to 4 pm, Monday-Friday
- 48-hour advance reservation required
- Same-day medical trips are provided if the trip can be worked into the schedule
- Serves the Cumberland County area
- Medical trips to Philadelphia, PA and Wilmington, DE

FLEET: 28 VEHICLES

- > 24 minibuses w/lift
- > 2 minivan w/lift
- 1 hybrid sedan
- 1 utility pickup truck (mechanic)

- Disabled Ambulatory Trips = 12,889
- Disabled Non-Ambulatory Trips = 4,749
- Other Trips = 3,402

UPDATE ON 2023 SHORT-TERM PROGRAM GOALS

1. Upgrade the bus fleet with the purchase of at least 2 new buses.

Two new buses and 2 vans were received in 2023.

- 2. Upgrade or replace the current routing software. Bids were received on August 16, 2023. Target to award contract to commence October 1, 2023.
- 3. All drivers to receive the latest PASS (Passenger Assistance Sensitivity and Safety) Training.

 This has been completed.

2023 SHORT-TERM PROGRAM GOALS

- 1. Upgrade the bus fleet with the purchase of at least 2 new buses.
- 2. Update and enhance the CATS Policy and Procedure Manual.
- 3. Expand service by adding at least one deviated fixed route.
