Interment Options

When the Spouse and/or Dependent of a Veteran predeceases the Veteran, Interment at the Cumberland County Veterans' Cemetery is permitted with the stipulation that upon the death of the Veteran, He / She agrees to be interred with/alongside with Spouse and/or Dependent. *Initial Here* _____

Interment Options

- No Interment Chooses not to be interred with Veteran at Veterans' Cemetery, therefore, no site will be reserved. Spouse/Dependent interment is only next to veteran. Once veteran interred, Spouse/Dependent is no longer eligible as interment elsewhere in the Cemetery is not permitted.

- Burial Only permitted in designated plot next to Veteran – Next of Kin must agree to purchase and have installed, Flat Bronze Marker for Spouse / Dependent within 3 months of Interment.

- Cremaains Permitted in designated plot next to Veteran – Next of Kin must agree to purchase Flat Bronze Marker for Spouse / Dependent within 3 months (including installation) of Interment.

- Permitted in same plot as Veteran ONLY if Veteran is also Cremaains – (VA will supply marker with veteran and spouse/dependent DOB and DOD on same marker if veteran deceased after 01 October 2019. Deceased prior to 01 October 2019 VA will supply marker with “Husband/Wife of “spouse name” or Mother/Father of “dependent name”).

I have read and understand these regulations, terms and options and will comply. Failure to comply with these regulations will result in the disinterment of the Veteran's Spouse and/or Dependent at the cost of the next of kin.
